Conversation with the Dean - August

Dr. Good's August 30 open session with faculty presented the status of the new Medical Education Building and transformation of the Health Science Center Campus. Groundbreaking will depend on securing additional funding, about half of which is already committed. Highlights of the proposed design will be multiple spaces for team learning, flexible simulation training and informal dialog and interaction.

Dean Good also presented the status of plans to adopt a UF-centric "brand" for the UF&Shands academic health center. The final identity has not been decided but will further solidify the unification of UF and Shands which will have many benefits as we move forward. Finally, the 2012-13 COM budget was reviewed.
